As per the recommendations and suggestions of the IQAC in the meetings organized in previous academic year, college has applied for PG courses i.e. M.Com and M.A. English, but due to some administrative hurdles, institution is not get the sanction by university to start these courses at present. So, IQAC suggest to introduce some vocational subjects in Bachelor of Arts in under graduate three year degree course. In the present time, job oriented education is the need of time, so IQAC suggest to introduce Journalism and Mass Communication as an elective subject in B.A. As college run B.Sc (Economics) with Math's, Computer Science and Economics as elective subjects, IQAC observed that during the time of admissions, some students not opt this stream due to the lack of interest in mathematics, although they want to study economics and computer science, so IQAC suggested to introduce Quantitative Techniques as an alternative of mathematics in this stream so that more students are benefitted through it.

On the basis of feedback available from parents and students, IQAC observed that many students as well as parents wanted that buses should go to villages which are far away from main road. As it was difficult for students especially girls to commute. Many students who visited college to take admission, not admitted as college bus was not available on their routes. So, IQAC suggested to start more buses and add new routes, so that more and more students can be benefitted.

IQAC also observed on the basis of students feedback that student learn new experiences through travelling, and also develop skills of being co-operative with each other. They also feel more confident by exploring themselves through the educational tours organized by college in the recent past and want that these type

of more tours will be organized in future also. So, IQAC suggest to organize more educational trips for students in the coming academic session.

IQAC also suggested that various cells that are active in college will take initiatives to organize seminars and guest lectures on different social and environment issues that are prevelant in Indian socio- economic scenario so that students become aware about the current situation of the country and increase their level of knowledge and become a responsible citizen of the country.
