MoUs and Collaborations

MoUs have been signed with various organizations to enhance educational and professional opportunities. On February 22, 2024, MoU was signed with Satkartar Career Development Institute, Fatehabad (Tarn Taran), for a duration of one year, involving approximately 60 students and 6 teachers in year-wise activities. Hans Raj Tubes Pvt.Ltd., Village Mandiala Amritsar, entered into a three-year agreement on March 11, 2024, benefiting approximately 15 students and 4 teachers annually. 

Student Support and Progression:

In the year 2023-24, various government and institutional schemes benefited students. Under the Dr.Ambedkar Scholarship, 58 students received a total amount of ₹803,843. Additionally, the Nishkam Sikh Welfare Council, funded by the Sikh Human Development Foundation, U.S.A (SHDF), supported 35 students with ₹372,000. The Sikh Review (The Sikh Cultural Centre, Calcutta) assisted 51 students, amounting to ₹1,062,005, while the Save Our Soul (SOS) charitable trust; Amritsar initiative helped 5 students, providing ₹162,075. In total, 58 students benefited from government schemes, receiving ₹803,843, while 91 students benefited from institutional schemes, receiving ₹1,596,080. 

NCC

NCC (National Cadet Corps) department have always significantly contributed to the personality and overall development of the students of our college. NCC department Incharge Prof. Hardev Singh was honored with the rank of Lieutenant in NCC, he is also the Alumni of our college and pride of the department. In collaboration with 11 PB BN NCC, Amritsar various events were organized by the dept. such as guest lecture by Commanding Officer CO. Birendra Kumar, and events such as Earth day. Awareness related to use of plastic, World Population day, Cycle Rally, Yoga day, campaigns like Puneet Sagar Abhiyan, with a focus on creating awareness and promoting social participation. These events observed active participation of the students. 45 cadets were enrolled in NCC on Aug 23. A total of 22 cadets appeared for NCC B and C certificate exams held in Feb. 2024

NSS

NSS conducted multiple activities, including campaigns like Swachhta Divas, seminars, and song competitions. The NSS also organized a 7-day camp focusing on campus beautification, garden upkeep, visits to a playground, government school, hostel, and a civil hospital. These activities, which aimed at fostering social responsibility and community service, involved 40 to 54 students each day. Through these programs, both NCC and NSS have made meaningful contributions to the academic, social, and personal growth of students while engaging them in societal welfare initiatives.

Departmental Activities:

Political Science

The Department of Political Science conducted several activities during the session. On November 21, 2023, an awareness lecture on voter awareness was organized. Additionally, in collaboration with the Department of Economics, an election training workshop under the Sveep initiative was held on November 28, 2023. A declamation competition was also conducted on March 11, 2024, to celebrate International Women's Day.

Computer Science

The Department of Computer Science organized various technical and practical activities. These included a poster-making competition on IT chart and innovation (September 12, 2023), an IT competition focused on code debugging (September 21, 2023), and a PPT competition on the topic "Wireless World: Future of Technology" (October 10, 2023). A fifteen-day workshop on the basics of website development using ASP.NET was held from October 4 to October 18, 2023. The department also organized an industrial visit to Simba Quartz at Tangra on February 9, 2024, and an IT competition titled "Code Marathon" on February 23, 2024. Lastly, a Seven-Day Workshop on computer basics was conducted from March 11 to March 18, 2024.

Economics

The Department of Economics engaged students with a variety of activities, including a quiz competition on micro and macroeconomics (September 19, 2023) and a board decoration competition titled "Decor Delight" (February 15, 2024). A PowerPoint presentation competition on budget analysis was held on March 20, 2024.

Science

The Science Department have always been pioneer in promoting scientific temperament among the student's of our region. Various dept. Activities are organized from time to time to develop interest for Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Guest lecture by Prof. (Dr.) Arvind, Hon. Vice-Chancellor of Punjabi University, Patiala, was held on November 10, 2023. This lecture focused on "New Inventions in the Field of Quantum Physics." On National Science Day (held on March 13, 2024) various competitions, including debate, PowerPoint presentation, poster-making, and quiz competitions, were conducted on this day.

Commerce

The Commerce Department conducted several skill-oriented activities. Department organized an activity of company formation (Yum Bites) on August 10,2023(Entrepreneur Day) . A group discussion on mock interviews took place on September 25, 2023, and a poster-making competition themed "Industry 4.0" was organized on October 11, 2023. Students visited Sukhraj Enterprises at Goindwal Sahib on October 14, 2023, for an industrial visit.A two day field survey was conducted by B.Com Students on December 23-24,2023 related to the topic upcoming Lok Sabha election in Punjab. On February 10, 2024, an extension lecture on "Opting Banking Services for Competitive Exams" was delivered. In collaboration with the Economics Department, an industrial visit to the Railway Coach Factory in Kapurthala was arranged on March 30, 2024.

Fashion Designing

The Fashion Designing Department arranged creative activities, including a Mehndi competition on August 18, 2023, and a one-day workshop on fabric painting on October 12, 2023. A poster-making competition on "International Earth Day" took place on April 10, 2024, followed by a rangoli and postermaking competition for voter awareness on April 20, 2024.

The Punjabi Department conducted several cultural and educational activities, A two-day workshop on Punjabi language writing skill enhancement was organized on August 16-17, 2023.
